## Michigan Teachers Workshop on Holocaust Education

This 10<sup>th</sup> annual Teachers Workshop is hosted by the Michigan State University Jewish Studies Program. This year the workshop will focus on **Children during the Holocaust**, and will include a morning kickoff by filmmaker and professor of media studies Elliot Caplan of the University of Buffalo. MSU faculty members and other guests will lead sessions. All interested teachers are welcome to submit applications, although the workshop is designed for teachers of English, History, Language Arts, Social Studies, and World History.

**INSTRUCTIONS: Applications must be received by Jewish Studies no later than Friday, March 14, 2008.** You will be notified of the status of your application through e-mail by **Friday, March 21, 2008**. A reading packet will follow in the mail early the next week. Enrollment is limited to 25 teachers to assure that all participants can fully participate. Applications will be evaluated based on personal statements.
